Main Presentation: This month we welcome Christopher Kolakowski. Christopher is the Director of the Wisconsin Veterans Museum, a position he has held since January 6, 2020. Chris received his BA in History and Mass Communications from Emory & Henry College, and his MA in Public History from the State University of New York at Albany. Chris has spent his career interpreting and preserving American military history with the National Park Service, New York State government, the Rensselaer County (NY) Historical Society, the Civil War Preservation Trust, Kentucky State Parks, the U.S. Army, and the MacArthur Memorial. He has written and spoken extensively on various aspects of military history and leadership from 1775 to the present. Chris has presented previously to the MHRT; *Perryville: Battle for Kentucky and The Admirals Wept: Billy Mitchell and the Atlantic Bombing Test of 1921*. This month, Chris will be presenting *Civil War to World War: The MacArthurs and the Buckners*. The presentation is about two father and son pairings who fought prominently in the Civil War and then World War II – Arthur and Douglas MacArthur and Simon Bolivar Buckner Sr and Jr. This talk will survey their lives in a parallel biography, noting some surprising intersections along the way."
