RE: December 2025 Meeting

Main Presentation: This month we welcome Dr. James Martin. Professor Martin will present his book **“The Sixth Wisconsin and the Long Civil War, The Biography of a Regiment”**. The presentation marshals a vast archive on the Sixth Wisconsin. The Sixth Wisconsin was one of the elements of the famed Iron Brigade. Drawing on an extraordinary wealth of letters, diaries, and records, Martin reveals how these soldiers—along with their families and communities—struggled with the physical and emotional scars of war, long after the battles ended. In seeing the fight through the eyes of the regiment’s roughly 2,000 men and those connected to them, readers will understand the long history of the Civil War as never before.

Dr. James Martin is an emeritus professor at Marquette University. He received a Ph. D. from the University of Texas. His academic and publishing interest has been the Civil War era and the histories of children and youth. He was president of the Society of Civil War Historians 2008-2012.
