## RE: April 2022, Encampment

**Main Presentation:** This month we welcome Henry M. Quinlan, Esq. Henry M. Quinlan is the owner and publisher of Omni Publishing Company. Between 1986 and 2018 Henry made more than 60 trips to the former Soviet Union and Russia. His most recent trip was to Moscow in 2018. The relationship started in 1986 when he signed an agreement with Vitaly Churkin to publish a book by him comparing living in Washington and Moscow. The book never happened but Vitaly and Henry kept in contact. Their last meeting was a dinner in August of 2016 when Vitaly was the Russian Ambassador to the UN. As a result of this dinner Henry was interviewed by the FBI as part of the Russian interference investigation. He lived in Moscow between 1988 and 1994 and during his time there traveled to most the Soviet Union Republics and later independent Republics. He witnessed history when the Soviet Union collapsed 1991. While engaged in a publishing venture in the former Soviet Union, Henry Quinlan was asked by President George H. Bush to organize the publishing of the children's book, "Make Way for Ducklings" in Russia in 1991. He attended the State Dinner President Bush hosted in honor of President Gorbachev in August of 1991 in Moscow.

Based on his first hand experiences with Russia, Henry will be presenting: **“Vladimir Putin - Corrupt, Competent, Brutal and Enigmatic”**. Come out and hear what promises to be a very insightful look inside Russia and Vladimir Putin. There will be no live streaming or recording of this presentation; so plan to attend in person.
