Main Presentation: This month we welcome David Powell. David is a Civil War author and will be presenting "Union Command Failure in the Shenandoah". David is a graduate of the Virginia Military Institute (1983) with a BA in history. He has published numerous articles in various magazines, and more than fifteen historical simulations of different battles. For the past decade, David's focus has been on the epic battle of Chickamauga, and he is nationally recognized for his tours of that important battlefield. His latest work "Union Command Failure in the Shenandoah", examines the Battle of New Market in the Shenandoah Valley which suffers from no lack of drama, interest, or importance. The ramifications of the May 1864 engagement, which involved only 10,000 troops, were substantial. Previous studies, however, focused on the Confederate side of the story. David's focus is on General Franz Sigel and the War in the Valley of Virginia, May 1864 which provides the balance that has so long been needed.
